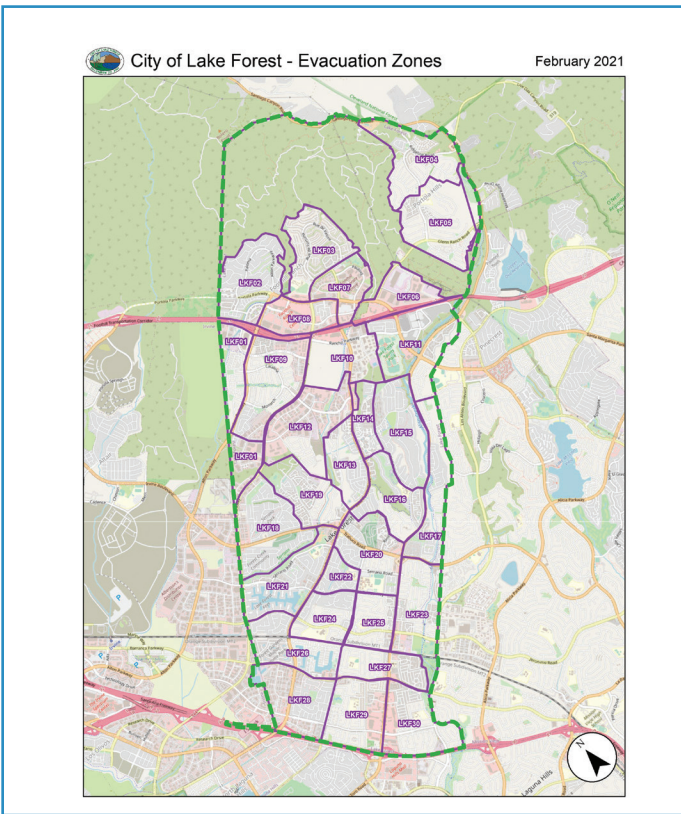

Did you know Lake Forest is divided into 32 evacuation zones? Even more importantly, do you know what zone your home or business is in? In a wildfire or other emergency, the Orange County Sheriff's Department and City will notify those in Lake Forest of potential evacuations by zone.

Learn your zone by entering your address in the interactive map at lakeforestca.gov/1042/Wildfires

The map will also be updated during an emergency to show which zones are under evacuation warnings, or full evacuations. And while the information is on the City's wildfire page, remember other emergencies, such as explosions or gas leaks, could lead to evacuations, as well.

CALIFORNIA REOPENING, STAY HOME ORDER LIFTED As of June 15, 2021, the Governor of California is terminating the executive orders that put into place the Stay Home Order and the Blueprint for a Safer Economy. This means that California's reopening tiers and business guidelines are no longer in effect. Lake Forest businesses listed in the current blueprint and activities and business tiers chart may return to normal operations, with limited exceptions for mega events (public events that include over 5,000 participants indoors or 10,000 outdoors). While nearly all State administered guidelines for the public are ending, rules for employees and businesses regarding face coverings are still evolving. The Division of Occupational Safety and Health, also known as Cal/OSHA, administers workplace safety and health regulations in California and is responsible for setting Covid-19 Prevention Emergency Temporary Standards. At this time, the State has issued the following guidance for businesses regarding face coverings:

In settings where masks are required only for unvaccinated individuals, businesses, venue operators, or hosts may choose to:

- Provide information to all patrons, guests, and attendees regarding vaccination requirements and allow vaccinated individuals to self-attest that they are in compliance prior to entry.
- Implement vaccine verification to determine whether individuals are required to wear a mask.
- Require all patrons to wear masks.

No person can be prevented from wearing a mask as a condition of participation in an activity or entry into a business.

CITY MANAGER'S MESSAGE

CITY NEWS

Lake Forest, The Natural Choice for Business

The City of Lake Forest has a strong tradition of supporting business development and has adapted and created new opportunities to support businesses during these unpredictable times. The City established a COVID-19 business resources page which includes helpful links and information on local, county, state, and federal resources to assist businesses as they navigate through the pandemic. The City ceased enforcement of many outdoor sign requirements, and the City Council approved an Emergency Temporary Outdoor Operating Permit, allowing a variety of businesses to utilize outdoor space, parking lots, and other outdoor areas to accommodate social distancing. Nearly 50 businesses have applied for this permit so that they may continue operating and serving Lake Forest residents.

Earlier this year, the Orange County Board of Supervisors received CARES Act funding to assist small businesses and nonprofit organizations that experienced financial difficulties throughout the coronavirus pandemic. Over 230 Lake Forest - based businesses were awarded grant funding through the Small Business Grant Relief program, having received economic support of up to \$10,000. The County also established the SafeDineOC Grant program to assist local restaurants, provided they reopen safely. Grants of up to \$1,000 were awarded to over 40 Lake Forest- based restaurants. In addition, the County established the OC Restaurant Outdoor Dining Grant program, providing \$1,000 grants to restaurants for the purchase of outdoor dining equipment, such as heaters/warmers, lighting canopies, and tents. Over 15 Lake Forest-based restaurants were awarded funding.

In partnership with the Orange County/Inland Empire Small Business Development Center, the City established a COVID-19 Small Business Relief Grant program to award grants up to \$1,000 to small businesses in the City of Lake Forest. The City hosted several webinars to spread awareness of the grants and relayed helpful information throughout the community. Each grant served as a reimbursement of personal protective equipment and utility bills to businesses impacted by the pandemic. The City will look to award grants and help reimburse small businesses for pandemic expenses once additional funds become available.

As the economy reopens, the City remains committed to serving the Lake Forest business community. Staff will continue to update the public as restrictions are lifted, provide access to city, county and state resources, establish partnerships with regional economic development organizations for new funding opportunities, and develop educational material for business owners. With the assistance of community partners at the Lake Forest Chamber of Commerce, SBA, SBDC, SCORE, and many more, the City's Economic Development initiatives will help Lake Forest businesses thrive.

RENTING THE CIVIC CENTER



Earlier this year, the City opened the Lake Forest Civic Center, the City's "100 Year Home." The campus consists of a Senior Center, Community Center, 200 seat Performing Arts Center/Council Chamber, Parking Structure, and City Hall. The City paid for the project with fees raised through the Opportunities Studies Area, a comprehensive planning process implemented to rezone nearly 838 acres of land. No debt was incurred throughout the entirety of this project.

The Campus has banquet and meeting rooms available for the public to rent. These spaces range in size and amenities to accommodate a variety of events including weddings, luncheons, ceremonies, conferences, seminars, classes, and more. Rentals can accommodate up to 400 people and have rooms that feature state-of-the-art audio and visual equipment. All rooms are

equipped with conference call and laptop connection capabilities, LCD or projector displays, ceiling speakers, and wireless internet availability. The campus also includes a large catering kitchen that allows caterers to serve at all day or multiday events.

Campus facilities endured full closure throughout the coronavirus pandemic. The closure remained consistent with mandates prepared by the State of California and County of Orange. With campus facilities now open to the public, the City looks forward to future reservations so that Lake Forest residents may begin utilizing the Civic Center as originally intended.
