Council Member Voigts pulled the warrant payable to MJS Café for separate consideration. He inquired if the Seniors St. Patrick's event was serviced by a Lake Forest business.

Staff reported MJS Café is located in Lake Forest with a billing address in Costa Mesa.

ACTION: On motion by Council Member McCullough and second by Council Member Voigts the City Council approved the warrant register in the amount of \$4,515,058.18 as submitted. MOTION CARRIED with Mayor Pro Tem Nick abstained on the warrant payable to Cummings and White, LLP.

ACTION: The City Council approved the Minutes as submitted.

*6. SUBMITTAL OF ANNUAL HOUSING ELEMENT PROGRESS REPORT TO HCD submitted by Director of Development Services.

ACTION: The City Council authorized staff to submit the Annual Housing Element Progress Report to the State Department of Housing and Community Development.

*7. FIRST CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH MARINA LANDSCAPE, INC., FOR LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE SERVICES submitted by Director of Public Works/City Engineer.

ACTION: The City Council: 1. Approved the first amendment with Marina Landscape, Inc., for Baker Ranch Community sports park landscape maintenance services. 2. Authorized the Mayor to sign, and the City Clerk to attest, the first contract amendment.

*8. CONSIDERATION OF AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF LAKE FOREST, ORANGE COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT, AND SHEA BAKER RANCH ASSOCIATES, LLC (SBRA) FOR THE CONSTRUCTON AND MAINTENANCE OF THE BORREGO LINEAR PARK AND TRAIL submitted by Assistant City Manager.

ACTION: The City Council: 1. Approved the Easement and Deed and Agreement between the Orange County Flood Control District and the City of Lake Forest, substantially in the form attached, and authorized the City Manager to execute the Agreement that would allow SBRA to construct the Borrego Linear Park and Trail and ensure its perpetual maintenance by either SBRA or the homeowners' association formed by SBRA for the Baker Ranch Community (i.e., Baker Ranch Community Association). 2. Authorized the City Clerk to execute the Certificate of

Acceptance for a non-exclusive easement from the Orange County Flood Control District for the installation and maintenance of Borrego Linear Park and Trail recreational improvements. 3. Approved the Easement Maintenance Agreement between the City of Lake Forest, Baker Ranch Community Association, and SBRA.

*9. SECOND AMENDMENT TO CITY HALL LEASE LOCATED AT 25550 COMMERCENTRE DRIVE submitted by Assistant City Manager.

ACTION: The City Council: 1. Approved the Second Amendment to Lease, substantially in the form attached, between the City of Lake Forest and CREF Pacific Vista, LLC to extend the term and reduce the rentable square footage to the lease for City Hall. 2.
