- Item 9: Discussion Regarding The Potential Development of an Ordinance to Regulate The Use of Drones
 - Senate Bill 347, currently in the Assembly Committee on Privacy and Consumer Protection and may be amended throughout the legislative process, would standardize drone use regulation statewide. This law would take effect regardless of whether a county or city adopts a local ordinance. At this time, City Council may choose to table a local drone ordinance until such time as either the Governor signs or vetoes the bill.
