Place the following items in your food waste container:

- All food preparation scraps
- All table scraps
- Spoiled food

Helpful tips:

- Make food waste containers easily accessible for staff.
- Make sure containers are labeled correctly so staff knows what material goes in each container.
- Provide training and educational material to staff. CR&R is available to assist in any training program, free of charge to your business.
- Bagging food waste for collection with compostable liners helps maintain a cleaner container and minimize odors.

Other Services

Bulky Items / E-waste / White Goods

Items that cannot properly fit in your bin, such as a chair or desk, are considered bulky items and require a special pick up. Electronic waste [e-waste] is anything with a circuit board or battery, such as computers, telephones and copiers. White goods [e.g. refrigerators, freezers] and electronic waste cannot be disposed of in your bin. CR&R will collect and properly dispose of and recycle these items for a charge. Hazardous Waste

Hazardous wastes are products that are flammable, corrosive, reactive, or toxic. This includes batteries of all types, as they are considered hazardous waste in California when they are discarded. Therefore, it is illegal to dispose of them in regular trash or recycling; so don't place them in CR&R containers. This includes batteries of all types and sizes Alkaline (AAA, AA, C, D, 9 Volt), Lithium (button cell, power tool batteries, camera batteries, other electronics), Ni Cad (power tools), and other battery types both rechargeable and single use. Batteries must be taken to one of the following:

- recycling center, or
- disposal facilities listed on oclandfills.com, or
- universal waste handler, or
- local retailer (Home Depot, Lowes, Best Buy, Staples, Ikea, etc.)

Why is it important? When lithium batteries are improperly disposed of they can cause fires in recycling centers, landfills, and garbage and recycling trucks.
