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LEARN HOW YOUR CITY WORKS

Ever wonder how Lake Forest works? Now's your chance to find out.

The Lake Forest Academy is an eight-week course traditionally held in the fall and provides participants with a general overview of City operations and departments. This year's first session is Wednesday, September 18.

The free series of in-depth seminars is geared towards enhancing community involvement and has developed community leaders since the spring of 2003. Participants hear from every department in the City over eight weeks.

The sessions include question-and-answer periods.

Additionally, first responders from the Orange County Sheriff's Department and Orange County Fire Authority present on how their agencies operate in Lake Forest. The utilities that serve the City also participate.

Applicants from all segments of the community are encouraged to participate. The Academy is open to participants 18 years and over who live in Lake Forest.

Sessions begin at 6 p.m. each Wednesday with appetizers. They are held at the Lake Forest Performing Arts Center. See www.lakeforestca.gov/lakeforestacademy for more information and to sign up.

CITY OFFERS TRANSLATION SERVICES DURING COUNCIL MEETINGS

The Lake Forest City Clerk's Office is coordinating a new service for those residents with limited English proficiency, providing a translator for residents who want to address the City Council during public comments.

According to the 2021, U.S. Census survey 14.1 percent of Lake Forest residents predominantly speak Spanish in the home and 12.7 percent predominantly speak one of the languages included in the Asian Pacific Islander category.

Those who prefer to make their public comments to the Council in Spanish or Chinese should request a translator need to be received by 8 a.m. the Monday before the scheduled City Council meeting. Such requests must be received via email at translationrequest@ lakeforestca.gov

The program is advertised in multiple languages on the City's agenda. It was also included in coupons sent to all Lake Forest homes, as well as displayed at the City's Multicultural Festival in June.

CITY CLERK'S OFFICE NOW OFFERS PASSPORT AND NOTARY SERVICES

The Lake Forest City Clerk's Office is also a Passport Acceptance Facility, authorized to accept new passport applications on behalf of the U.S. Department of State. The City will forward applications and supporting documents to the U.S. Department of State for processing.

Applications are processed by appointment from 9 am to 4 pm. on Wednesdays and Fridays. Morning appointments are encouraged. Recorded information is available at (949) 461-3537, and online at www.lakeforestca.gov/en/passports

CITY BEEFS UP SIDEWALK VENDING ENFORCEMENT

In July, the City Council approved an ordinance allowing city staff to impound sidewalk vending equipment that poses environmental, health, or safety hazards. This action follows the 2018 Safe Sidewalk Vending Act (SB 946), which decriminalized street vending but allowed cities to impose health and safety regulations.

The City established a permit program requiring insurance, indemnification, background checks, and limitations on vending locations. However, many vendors have ignored these regulations, leading to issues such as blocking public rightsof-way, property damage, and unsanitary food practices.

Hot food vendors often fail to meet health requirements like proper food storage, handwashing facilities, and waste disposal. The new ordinance empowers code enforcement officers to impound equipment after issuing warnings and creates an appeal process for vendors.

Food trucks may still operate if they obtain the necessary permits from the OCHCA and comply with health regulations.

Residents are encouraged to report illegal street vendors to code enforcement through AskLakeForest.com by providing the time and location of violations. Staff has worked to balance vendor interests with the city's commitment to public health and safety.



CITY JOINS WITH LAGUNA HILLS TO SAVE ON WASTE HAULING

CR&R will continue collecting waste and recyclables in the City of Lake Forest after the City Council joined with Laguna Hills to create an agreement that will save residents in both cities \$7.35 million annually.

The current agreement with CR&R for solid waste services in the city expires on June 30, 2025. The cities of Lake Forest and Laguna Hills teamed up to seek proposals, believing the larger service area would result in lower proposed rates. The process was guided by an ad-hoc committee of staff and City Council members from both cities, along with an expert consultant hired by both cities.

The committee met six times in 2023 to make recommendations to the Request for Proposals, which included the details of the services the cities wanted. The Lake Forest City Council unanimously selected CR&R for the new agreement in June.

Seven waste haulers attended a mandatory pre-bid meeting. CR&R and Valley Vista Services, based in Los Angeles County, submitted bids. City staff noted both companies submitted comprehensive, well thought out proposals, but a thorough analysis showed the main difference came down to cost.

The CR&R proposal included

\$22.61 million in fees for both cities, while Valle Vista proposed \$29.96 million annually. Over a 10-year period,

the difference is \$73.5 million less to rate payers for both cities. Specifically to Lake Forest, the CR&R proposal was \$5.12 million less than the Valle Vista proposal annually and \$51.2 million less over a 10-year period.

Tackling the agreement together also showed savings for residents: CR&R's proposed costs are \$22.92 million for the combined contract, compared to separate agreements that would have totaled \$22.61 million annually. That is a savings of \$314,000 annually, or \$3.14 million over a 10year agreement.

The agreement will see rates climb 8.8 percent, to \$25.02 monthly for the largest trash bin. All residents will receive new trash bins when the contract takes effect – one for green and food waste, one for recycling, and one for waste. The new agreement also calls for residents to receive four bulky item pickups annually.

10 YEARS STRONG: LAKE FOREST SPORTS PARK MILESTONE

When the closure of the Marine Corps Air Station El Toro was identified for closure, the nearby property owners recognized an opportunity: their land was more valuable as homes than the commercial/industrial uses locked in because of noise from the military base.

When they approached the City about changing the landuse designation, City leaders recognized an opportunity, too, to provide residents with new amenities. When asked, residents responded loud and clear: Lake Forest needed a sports park!

Public workshops and design sessions began in 2008. The Parks and Recreation Commission and then the City Council approved the Consensus Plan in 2009. A preferred project blueprint drafted by RJM Design Group was selected and environmental reports approved in 2011, followed by a construction contract with Park West.

The grand opening for the Lake Forest Sports Park and Recreation Center was held in 2014, and the applause heard in the Council Chambers with each approval was replaced with cheers for boys and girls playing baseball, soccer, basketball, and other sports.

The 86-acre park is one of the largest sports parks in Orange County, with 57 acres devoted to sports fields and a 27,000-square-foot multi-functional recreational center. Today, it's home to 24 baseball and soccer tournaments, hundreds of recreation classes every year, summer concerts, movies, the Lake Forest Farmers' Market, and more.

The total cost of the park, including complex property acquisitions that include land swaps with the County and assembling parcels held by different owners, was about \$80 million. The Sports Park and Recreation Center, along with the Civic Center, roadway improvements such as Alton and Rancho parkways, and trail links were all paid for by the developers who went on to build Baker Ranch, Whisler Ridge, Portola Center, Serrano Summit, and the Pinnacle.

The Grand Opening of the Lake Forest Sports Park and Recreation Center was November 1, 2014. This year, the public is invited once again to celebrate the Park's 10th anniversary from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. on October 26, 2024.

PEDAL PALOOZA ELEVATES BIKE SAFETY AWARENESS

Pedal Palooza, held at Oakley Headquarters in Foothill Ranch, successfully elevated the message of bicycle safety in collaboration with the Orange County Sheriff's Office, Orange County Fire Authority, Oakley, Bosch Bicycles, and Mission Hospital.

The event attracted over a hundred attendees and featured a stunt BMX demonstration that highlighted the importance of wearing safety gear. Various giveaways from participating vendors added to the excitement. Additionally, Oakley opened its shop and museum for attendees to explore. The event was a resounding success in promoting bicycle safety.



Top Five Safety Suggestions for Youth Riding eBikes



- 1 Always Wear a Helmet: Ensure your helmet fits properly and is securely fastened to protect your head in case of falls or collisions.
- **2** Follow Traffic Rules: Obey all traffic signals, signs, and laws. Ride in the same direction as traffic and use designated bike lanes whenever possible.
- 3 Be Visible: Equip your eBike with front and rear lights and wear bright or reflective clothing to make sure you are seen by drivers and pedestrians, especially in low-light conditions.
- Stay Alert and Aware: Keep an eye on your surroundings, avoid distractions such as using your phone while riding, and be cautious of cars, pedestrians, and other cyclists.
- 5 Perform Regular Safety Checks: Before each ride, check your eBike's brakes, tires, and battery to ensure everything is in good working order. Regular maintenance can prevent accidents and keep you safe on the road.

CITY ADDS SAFE BICYCLE STORAGE TO PARKS

Bicycle riders will now find safe places to lock up their rides at seven Lake Forest parks, where stainless steel bicycle racks have been installed.

Etnies Skatepark of Lake Forest, Lake Forest, Montbury, Peachwood, Portola, and Tamarisk parks have the new equipment, which can secure up to nine traditional or electric bicycles. Two more parks, Borrego Overlook and Regency, are also getting new bike racks set on concrete pads.

The City installed the racks after seeing an uptick in park users riding bicycles.

KNOW YOUR ZONE: BE PREPARED FOR EVACUATIONS

Remember all of that rain last winter? It created lush, wild vegetation that is now drying out. As temperatures climb, so does the risk of wildfire.

Lake Forest, like other South County cities, is divided into evacuation zones for planning and to ensure residents get clear and accurate information during an emergency. Residents should ensure they know their zones.

If an evacuation is ordered because of wildfire or other emergency, authorities will identify evacuation areas by the zone, rather than try to describe them by street boundaries or other landmarks.

Authorities and the City will communicate with residents through www.alertoc.org and www. nixle.com. Ensure you and your loved ones are registered with those services and the information is up to date, as alerts are set to specific geographic areas.

If an evacuation is ordered, residents should leave immediately. Waiting until the last moment is not only dangerous, it can create a traffic nightmare if Orange County Sheriff's Deputies and Firefighters are trying to enter an area while residents are fleeing.


Remember, once you leave an evacuation area, you cannot reenter it for any reason until the order is lifted. If you ignore an evacuation order, authorities may not be able to respond to your call for help.

HUNDREDS GATHER TO HONOR THE LEGACY OF MCAS EL TORO

Over 200 people attended an event celebrating the legacy of Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) El Toro, learning about its history and impact on Lake Forest. The highlight of the July 10 event at the Lake Forest Performing Arts Center was a performance by the 3rd Marine Aircraft Wing Band, led by Gunnery Sgt. Justin Grunes.

Brig. General James Shuts, a former MCAS El Toro commander, began the evening by describing the Marine Corps' acquisition of the land for the base, along with the Tustin Lighter-than-Air Base, from farmer James Irvine. Opened in 1943, the base grew into the largest Marine aviation operation on the West Coast, training pilots for World War II and every conflict until its closure in July 1999.

It was noted that MCAS El Toro was the last place on U.S. soil that many service members ever touched before leaving for duty around the world, never to return. Lisa Hollingsworth shared the story of her father's death in a 1965 transport plane crash that killed 84 servicemen. Her mother was pregnant with her at the time—her father never got to hold her, and she never got to meet him. Hollingsworth, who finished her story by asking for a moment of silence for all who gave their lives for their country, received a standing ovation from those in attendance.

It was also noted that many refugees first touched U.S. soil at El Toro when they were airlifted from Vietnam, leading to the formation of "Little Saigon" in Westminster.

Lake Forest Community Development Director, Gayle Ackerman, told attendees that landowners near the base had been restricted to commercial uses on about 650 acres during its operation. Upon its closure, they requested a change to residential zoning, ultimately leading to the creation of several new communities: Whisler Ridge, Baker Ranch, Portola Center, Serrano Summit, and The Pinnacle.



In exchange for changes to the General Plan that greatly increased property values, homebuilders funded several community benefits:

- A 40-acre Sports Park and Recreation Center
- A Civic Center, including City Hall, a Community Center, a Senior Center, and a Performing Arts/City Council Chamber
- New road improvements

Ackerman told the audience that the plan, called the "Opportunities Study," ultimately led to 6,500 residential units, including affordable housing, along with \$175 million in development agreement fees for "public benefits" for Lake Forest residents and businesses. No special taxes were placed on residents, and the plan contributed to Lake Forest being a debt-free city today.

Much of the base itself became the Great Park in Irvine, which will house the Flying Leatherneck Aviation Museum. Brig. General Michael Aguilar shared plans for the museum, which will include aircraft that flew from the base and interactive displays. Attendees were encouraged to vote for their favorite "taste" throughout the event. Urban Grill and Wine Bar won the "Best Taste of Lake Forest," Board & Brew and A Little Something Sweet tied for 2nd place, and Bravo Avo took home the 3rd-place trophy.

The event sold out, with over 1,000 people in attendance.






