
Gents:

I talked with Tom yesterday. He forwarded me the attached emails regarding the project. It appears that delivery isn't due until 9/1/24. Mark, at our PM rate of \$195, there would be about 51 hours available, or fewer PM hours with some support staff hours for tedium...

A rough estimate to implement this would be:

Procure designer: 6-8 weeks

- Administer Design / permits: 12-16 weeks
- Bid / award / contract execution: 8-12 weeks
- Long Lead procurement (Shade structure deferred submittal, A/E review, plancheck review and approval / fabrication/ delivery): 18-24 weeks
- Construction: 12 weeks
- Total 56 to 72 weeks... averaging well less than an hour of PM per week if we sign on to do this for under \$10k.

Let me know how you guys want to approach this / what assistance you need from me.



Doug/Tom:

Good to see you both and to meet with you yesterday to discuss the various projects. The following is a summary of my takeaway from our meeting. If anyone has anything more to add to the conversation, by all means chime in.

First order of business is to establish kick off meetings with the four design firms retained for the "12" projects (the "12" – kinda sounds like the motto of the 12th man for the Seattle Seahawks). Doug, if you would provide me with the contact information for each of the four firms I will reach out to set up those meetings. It will be my intent to schedule them for 30-45 mins back to back . . . on the same day. I figure that will work well for flow. Let me know what works best for you in the next couple weeks to basically set aside a morning or afternoon for these meetings.

As for project priority, Bake/Baffin Bay median is first priority to get out on the street.

The El Toro package of projects by Tait is to be packaged in such a way as to have that as one bid package but separated in the bid schedules to provide for ease of financial tracking for the various pots of funding. For all projects, it is desirable to get a reasonable rough order of magnitude cost estimate at a 30% or similar design level to see where we are financially and if scope changes need to be accommodated to adequately address funding commitments/timelines.

For each of the four consultants, we will be requesting project schedules with milestone and deliverables timelines. It will be expected that these will reasonably match the delivery table that you shared in our meeting last month (the colorful spreadsheet entitled 12 (+1) Street Projects Delivery Table). There are some near term deliveries for design of medians that are coming up fairly soon.

As for on-going effort, once we get started we (Dennis and I) will be coordinating efforts with the various design teams to keep these projects on track. We will provide you with updates on a regular basis (interval TBD) and will coordinate (email, phone call, meeting) when there are milestone activities and/or pivot points that are critical to the final outcome and would benefit from your input/direction.

As for the shade structure at the Sr. Ctr, we will coordinate with the architect once you have him under contract. In the meantime, Dennis can work internally to search through files for any info that might be helpful to understanding a rough order of magnitude cost for the intended scope. Based upon the conversation yesterday, I believe it is reasonable to expect that some sort of design procurement might be necessary to develop a bid package to be able to retain a contractor for construction. If that is the vision, then we can begin developing an appropriate RFP that will ultimately incorporate the architect's design concept. It would be an excellent turn of events if the architect that is being retained currently can develop the design well enough to be able to assemble a bid package that is biddable and constructable from the design concept. We can work with our CM group to solicit their input once we have a better idea of what the architect's design development will look like. We can track this as it develops and see the direction in which we need to head.

I hope I have at least captured the essence of our discussion yesterday. If there are any more details or direction that I have either missed or you feel are needed at this time, by all means please fire away.

Looking forward to working with you to get these projects delivered.
