As a quick update for you, we have been wrestling with incorporating the Jeronimo Road widening segment in to the package as a whole which has delayed our distribution of the plans. In further review of the limits of work, due to the fact that we are creating dual left turns on El Toro at Jeronimo, the striping transition leading to the intersection in both directions extends a good distance. Rather than trying to isolate all of those items in the Jeronimo package, I am, instead, lumping them in to the El Toro Median Package (especially since the funding is the same source) and trying to present in a more linear fashion. Unfortunately, the transfer of data between the old and the new jobs and correlation of the notes has taken us longer than initially anticipated. At this point I am anticipating updated packages to be ready tomorrow and I will be compiling the plans and estimates for distribution to you on Friday end of day or Monday Morning.

Thanks for your patience on this and I will look forward to getting these items in for review shortly.
