Sorting Out Food Waste Laws

If your business handles food, you've probably heard the alphabet soup of laws regarding food waste: AB 1826, AB 827, SB 1383. It can leave the average person scratching their head, wondering what it all means for their business.

Here's a short guide to help sort it all out:

AB 1826 Mandatory Commercial Organics Recycling

> Requires businesses and multifamily properties to separate food

scraps and landscape waste from trash

AB 827 Mandatory Organics Recycling Bins

Requires food-generating establishments where customers consume food on premise and bus their own tables, to provide separate food scraps, recyclables, and trash containers in front-of-house.

SB 1383 Mandatory Food Waste Reduction

Commercial and multi-family

properties are required to set up a food scrap program, similar to AB 1826. In addition, certain edible food generators are required to donate edible food to food recovery organizations.

And, food scrap recycling containers are offered at half the cost of trash service, so you may be able to comply with state law at no additional cost!




