- One set of technical studies






Project 1 - Existing Site

Project Proposal also includes:


Off-site improvements at 5 intersections within the City to enhance public safety and address truck turning movements.

- 5. Lake Forest Drive/Rancho Parkway





Environmental Scoping Meeting Objectives

- Provide an opportunity for public participation in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) process.
- Allow the public and reviewing agencies to identify environmental issues to be analyzed in the Environmental Impact Report (EIR).

Key Project Elements

Project 1:

- Demolition of three (3) existing two-story office buildings totaling 150,000 sf at 26110, 26140, and 26160 Enterprise Way
- Construction of two (2) new 35-foot tall, industrial buildings totaling 156,800 sf (one 54,000 sf building and one 102,800 sf building)

Project 2:

- Demolition of the existing 76,978 sf two-story office building at 26250
 Enterprise Way
- Construction of a new 35-foot tall, 77,000 sf industrial building



Key Project Elements - Continued

- Both projects includes dock high doors, a truck loading area, parking spaces, and new landscaping.
- The proposed buildings are intended to be occupied by industrial businesses that are allowed by the zoning district, including but not limited to, office, manufacturing, and warehouse.
- The project EIR will analyze proposed off-site improvements at 5 intersections within the City to enhance public safety, address truck turning movements, and as an additional benefit to the City of Lake Forest.
